Nouns tell us about the number of things they name.
Nouns that refer to one person or thing are called singular nouns.
a flower, an ice cream, a boy, a tiger
Nouns that refer to more than one person or thing are called plural nouns.
rivers, bodies, benches, toys, girls
We can change singular nouns into their plural forms in many ways.
We add -s to most nouns to form plurals.
