NOUNS

Countable and Uncountable Nouns

Countable nouns are those which have singular and plural forms. They can be preceded by number and quantity words.

countable noun singular	plural	with number words	with quantity/ counting words
bottle	bottles	<i>six bottles</i>	<i>many bottles</i>
teacher	teachers	<i>two teachers</i>	<i>each teacher</i>
woman	women	<i>one hundred women</i>	<i>several women</i>
mountain	mountains	<i>three mountains</i>	<i>those mountains</i>
baby	babies	<i>twenty babies</i>	<i>these babies</i>

Uncountable nouns are nouns which don't have a plural form, and cannot be used with number words.

uncountable noun	plural (not possible)	with counting words (not possible)
music	musics	two musics
furniture	furnitures	ten furnitures
health	healths	many healths
gold	golds	each gold
bread	breads	every bread
