Rest: A body is said to be in a state of rest when its position does not change with respect to a reference point.

Motion: A body is said to be in a state of motion when its position changes continuously with reference to a point.

Scalar quantities: The physical quantities having magnitude but no direction e.g., distance, speed, mass

Vector quantities: The physical quantities that requires both magnitude and direction e.g., displacement, velocity, force, acceleration
